3. PAKISTAN AND THE FUTURE OF KASHMIR CAUSE.

1. Introduction

The Kashmir cause has 73 years of a miserable historical background. Crippling masses collapsed economic life, no judiciary, and a list of injustices are out there as the specifications of the occupied Kashmir and Pakistan is lethargic in this regard. If Pakistan would have been a prominent member out there in the United Nations, Other members of the United Nations would have been voted in favour of Pakistan and the Kashmir cause so far. And the Kashmir issue would have been resolved so far in favour of both Pakistan and Kashmir. However, unfortunately Pakistan is not that much an active member of the United Nations because of various factors. Which include dishonest politicians, lack of experience in the world peace that much, under developed status, IMF and World Bank loans, and at the end (Pakistan) not been involved by the United Nations in other peace concerns of the world. Which kept the confidence of Pakistan low in the United Nations. And made Pakistan and the future of the Kashmir cause unpredictable.

2. Current Scenario of The Kashmir Cause and Pakistan

2.1- Because of the Indian interference in the occupied Kashmir there used to be rallies and protests, and in return lock down and curfew on daily basis, and the Killing of the innocent masses since 1947 by the Indian army forces, which is like a lifelong trend there.

2.2- Masses are crippled there because of the spoilage of business in the occupied Kashmir. People sacrifice their lives for the cause of Kashmir, when they come out of their houses.

2.3. Education system and health services has rotten the lives of the public there. They cannot acquire education unless they go abroad. And their health services are restricted.

2.4- There is no concept of recreation. And there is no relief for the public from the lifelong depression, confusion, and anxiety. Almost all the people suffer from psyche disorders.

2.5- Other government services are also restricted there and public goes outside from Kashmir to acquire employment. Almost the whole life of masses is disturbed there with a helpless Pakistan in this regard. And the only trend which is common there is the sacrifice of the lives of the masses for the cause of Kashmir.

3. Obvious Factors Which Sustained the Kashmir Cause and Bored Pakistan In This Regard

3.1- The negligence of the United Nations about the Kashmir cause and the fatigued and not heard struggle of Pakistan in the United Nation caused the sustained of the conflicted and controversial Kashmir.

3.2- Other regional organizations for peace did do any successful struggle for the Kashmir cause and the controversial Kashmir faced sustainability of its such a conflicted condition.

3.3- The presence of the Indian army forces in the territory of conflicted Kashmir is another basic reason behind the current conditions of the occupied Kashmir. Where no organization for regional peace did not put up the issue of the occupied Kashmir to the Indian government.

3.4- Member countries of the United Nations never weighed in voting more in favour of Pakistan and Kashmir than India. And because of the disagreement between Pakistan and India about Kashmir prolonged the Kashmir issue for such a historical long time.

3.5- The absence of Pakistani army forces in the occupied Kashmir made the Kashmir issue did exist, as it in return kept the morale of Indian government and its armed forces high. Which is against the Kashmir issue. And the issue of the occupied Kashmir remained controversial and conflicted so far.

4. Threats to The International Peace from The Kashmir Cause and Unsuccessful Pakistan In This Regard

4.1- As per the human nature masses across the globe do not feel safe because of the Kashmir cause. As they see the unsuccessful attempts of the United Nations in this regard. And condemn it.

4.2- The inflicted masses are hopeless in the occupied Kashmir. They raise their voice on media to the outside world about their miserable life. And the United Nations along with other regional organization for peace have lost their reputation among the global public.

4.3- Occupied Kashmir is posing threat to the morale of Pakistani army forces in this regard and enhancing the brutality of the Indian army forces. This effect of the current occupied Kashmir is because of the failure in agreements of both the Indian and Pakistani governments with each other.

4.4- The bilateral relationship of Pakistan with other Muslim countries in this regard affect the reputation of Pakistan among these Muslim countries. This in return affect the relationship of Pakistan with such Muslim countries. As they see the repetition of the failure of Pakistan about the Kashmir cause.

4.5- So far Pakistan did not owned Kashmir on the basis of voting in the United Nations. Those countries who vote against Pakistan and occupied Kashmir, obviously look down on Pakistan in the United Nations and the issue of Kashmir does look to exist for an unpredictable time. And the ties of Pakistan are weakening there with foreign countries.

5. Lessons the World Learned from The Kashmir Cause and Pakistan.

5.1- The brutality of Indian army forces in the occupied Kashmir is inhumane. The world on the basis of humanistic values condemn the United Nations, India, and Pakistan for the current Kashmir cause. As they see that the Kashmir like cause can be possible against any dependent nation.

5.2- The issue of the occupied Kashmir is the obvious failure of the pro-peace organizations. And this has weakened the supremacy of the United Nations almost since its establishment. The world seek solution to the issue of the occupied Kashmir from the United Nations.

5.3- Those countries which are in favour of the will of the Kashmiri Public, see the Pakistani army un-interested and weak in this regard. Otherwise such a tight army, like Pakistan do have, can resolve the issue of the occupied Kashmir very easily with its hard power there in.

5.4- Kashmir issue is an example of the lack of peace in this region like the issue of peace of Palestine, and Chechnya does exist. And the Human Rights are daily jeopardized because of the crippling masses. The Kashmir issue is in this form since 1947. And the blood loss of Kashmiris has a very hard traditional history. The whole world is against this blood loss. And they see this as the misfortune of the Kashmiri masses. However, the Kashmiri masses and the outside world except India are still hopeful and relate it to God.

5.5- Kashmir issue is so much an ignored issue that even if the Kashmiri masses need help, no country does help the Kashmiri public except Pakistan. Where on the humanistic basis other countries must help out the Kashmiris with different packages. But as far as the issue of independence of the occupied Kashmir is concerned Pakistan needs a higher hand over India both in this region and out there in the United Nations.

6. Permanently Eliminating the Factors Backing Up the Kashmir Issue and Creating A Hopeful Pakistan In This Regard

6.1- Pakistan must have a prominent place in the United Nations. For which Pakistan has to improve its ties with those countries who vote against the will of the Kashmiris and resist Pakistan about the Kashmir cause.

6.2- Organizations for peace in this region must have meetings and seminars at times about the will of the Kashmiris and the will of our country about the Kashmir cause.

6.3- Indian government must have a policy on humanistic basis about the occupied Kashmir. Indian government must eliminate its army forces as it is against the will of the Kashmiri masses.

6.4- Kashmiri public must have a successful domestic peace organization and campaigns to get their voice high about their will and their rights. United Nations must give a special focus and concentration to such a voice of Kashmiris, which needs and seeks to be raised on the international forum also.

6.5- Those countries which vote against the will of the Kashmiris and Pakistan in the UNO, must develop a sense of humanism and must vote in favour of the Kashmir cause.

6.6- The United Nations must also support the presence of Pakistani army forces in the occupied Kashmir. Which can develop a sense of safety and security in the occupied Kashmir about its masses.

7. Designing the Road Map for A Happy Future of The Kashmir Cause and The Quality Pakistan For the Kashmir Cause

7.1- The land of the occupied Kashmir must be free from any sort of brutality of Indian army. The Indian government must eliminate its brutal army from the occupied Kashmir. Where only the domestic army of Kashmir must exist. As Kashmir needs to be self-sufficient in this regard. Even if Kashmir becomes a part of Pakistan Kashmir must have its own army.

7.2- The prestige of Pakistan will raise and will get higher if Pakistan wins over Kashmir on its own part. And Kashmir needs to have a safe stability like other provinces under the jurisdiction and the federation of Pakistan.

7.3- Kashmir must not become a part of the Indian government ever. As the Indian government has been a lifelong enemy of the rights of the Kashmiri public. Kashmir can never or can extremely hardly adjust under the jurisdiction and the federation of the Indian government. If Kashmir becomes a part of the Indian government, Kashmiri masses will still be crippled for their rights under the prejudiced jurisdiction and prejudiced federation of the Indian government.

7.4- The United Nations must give a special focus and purified concentration to the issues like Kashmir, Chechnya and Palestine on humanistic grounds. It will add a wave of peace the global public. And the crippled masses will love life. The life which needs to be celebrated.

7.5- Regional Organizations responsible for peace need to be successful. They need a special media coverage and more than needed seminars in this regard, to make the peace sure for the crippled masses across Kashmir. There is a need for more organizations to be established for peace across the world.

8. Conclusion

Until and Unless God is agreed the Muslim masses of Kashmir will be crippled for their rights. However, there is a special need to make the God agreed for this. Here it is the responsibility of Kashmiris along with the Muslim countries especially Pakistan to make the God agreed and take the Kashmiris out of their life long depression, confusion, and anxiety for the Kashmir cause. Which seeks such a collective effort. As God says He never changes the cause of a nation until and unless they strive properly to change it themselves. Secondly the responsible states around the world must support the Kashmir cause as Pakistan is the most special state in this regard. Still we can hope that the Kashmir can alter its historical chapter from a dark one to a bright one.

4. POLARIZED POLITICS: THE ISSUES AND CHALLENGES OF DEMOCRACY IN PAKISTAN.

1. Introduction

This is a polarized Pakistan because of the polarized politicians. Who run after political power to become self-authoritative? And avoid what authority actually means when a politician is elected through voting. Here all the political parties compete against each other striving for power. Authority acquired through voting actually means to provide proper rights to the citizens of a state, to listen to the voice of masses and provide justice, to purify the politics, to spend time among public and show genuine interest in masses where media helps, and to make the executive branch of such state work with genuine efforts for public. However, each politician in Pakistan either who become federal ruler or provincial ruler tend to become self-authoritative and hustle to live more and more luxury life, without any good and genuine interest in masses.

2. What Is A Genuine Government of Democracy, And Its Qualities

2.1- A genuine and classic democracy is there where all the citizens of a state are considered equal and women equivalent to men. They are given equal rights, equal life standards and acceptable privileges varied among masses. Also, these citizens who acquire these things have to fulfil their responsibilities up-to the mark and to the fullest.

2.2- A genuine democracy is that where the authority holders have to care more about the state and its masses than themselves. What the authority holders have to care more about themselves than the state and its citizens is just their health, and not engulfing the wealth of the state and its masses. Subsiding the state and suppressing the rights of the public must be avoided.

2.3- A genuine democracy is that where the authority holders are not self-authoritative and personally strong. But where the institutions are strong serving the masses honestly is an illustration of a good democracy.

2.4- A genuine democracy is that where voting is fair, justice is cheap and easily acquired, media is free and just, politicians are sincere and economy is free from corruption and bankruptcy, and the public is involved in and considered by the authorities when public decisions are made.

2.5- A genuine democracy is that where employment for the masses is easy in approach and acquirement, poverty is minimum, literacy is common, health is wealth, and no prejudice is held among the politicians, i.e., no concept of polarized politics is there.

3. The Polarized Politics in Pakistan And the Issues of Democracy

3.1- Polarized Politics has been a trend of governance in Pakistan since the early 70s. This trend has weakened the so-called democratic governance in Pakistan. Most prominent issue related with the polarized politics in Pakistan is that political parties are family-oriented where such politicians acquire political power for luxuries among personal families. Like PPP, PML(N), etc are the similar examples to rule Pakistan.

3.2- The ignored and crippling masses is another major issue of the polarized politics in Pakistan. Where the masses are the target of inflation, poverty, unemployment, and over all low quality of life.

3.3- Weak institutions in Pakistan due to polarized politics are not fair and sincere with Pakistani public. Where mostly the approach finders are benefited and the rest oscillate there, away from justice in depression, confusion, and a difficult survival.

3.4- Media is used personally by the polarized politicians for personal and their political party name, fame, and gains. Plus, the media is kept restricted to not raise the actual voice of the masses for their rights. Wherein they are left amid the problems and challenges of life they cannot resolve themselves. Also, the polarized politics in Pakistan gets extended mostly successfully for a tenure while posing controversial acts in the parliament, suffocating the institutions, and not helping resolve the problems and challenges masses do face in their lives.

3.5- Due to polarized politics the bankruptcy, due to the loans of IMF and World Bank for the state of Pakistan, is escalating with time. The un-affordable inflation for masses and the raise in taxes each year is another massive blow for the masses from the side of polarized politicians in Pakistan.

4. Challenges of Democracy with Polarized Politicians in Pakistan

4.1- The state of Pakistan is facing the problem of an exhausted democracy. Where there has been mostly a game of hide-and-seek between the politicians in power and opposition to the government in rule. Such politics are dry-hard and non-productive for the masses.

4.2- The state machinery is not running properly. And is not integrated. The state machinery of Pakistan has lost flexibility between the authorities in power and the oriented masses. A wave of hopelessness is there in the atmosphere due to the polarized politics in Pakistan.

4.3- Citizens are facing daily injustice due to the polarized politics. Only those people acquire justice (sometimes fake) who have some reference of the polarized authorities. The rest dwindle there in injustice on routine basis.

4.4- Economy use to be the backbone of each and every state. In Pakistan the polarized politicians are supporting this economy by the taxes imposed by these polarized politicians on the impotent citizens on one way. While on the other hand bankruptcy and corruption has hollowed the economy of Pakistan.

4.5- Weak authorities use to be less responsible and use to fulfil their duties less. Here they use to reach less to their required goals and destinations and the same intended goals and destinations of the masses in Pakistan are less met where state is responsible for. As we all have seen this weakness been developed by the polarized politicians like a required trend.

4.6- Also the masses have no awareness about the polarized politics. As polarized politicians care more about themselves than the public. Public have no genuine sense of real democracy and good governance. Voters (except the party workers) vote foolishly been the fans of political parties.

5. Factors Behind the Issues and Challenges of Democracy with Polarized Politicians in Pakistan.

5.1- The Election Commission of Pakistan concede a lot in this regard. The election commission of Pakistan has not established any rules to restrict the polarized politics in this country.

5.2- Unaware masses of Pakistan except some have no concept of the polarized politics. Who then suffer from unwanted consequences?

5.3- Media booting up the polarized politicians, keep the Pakistani citizens unaware in this regard. Where in the goal of media is just cultivating sensationalism? As these polarized politicians give monetary back up to media, and use it for their personal reputation. Which the citizens less understand and become fans of the polarized party in power due to this sensationalism.

5.4- Bad governance has been a worst defect of the polarized party in power along with a heated opposition. However, this defect is not cured, as the politics in Pakistan is just a game of mind. Where the role of opposition is not that much marvellous. Because of an edge of the media to the opposition. So, this is like survival for the fittest. And the polarized party in power mostly wins over for its tenure of five years.

5.5- Polarized Politicians do not take in heed the institutions of this state that much serious. Where inner personal benefits and luxuries are enjoyed by the authorities of such institutions. Also, the Pakistani public is fatigued because of this while still vote blindly. The opposition is less exposed by the media, and the polarized politicians in power take the pleasure of luxurious governance, with irresponsible and less fulfilment of their duties. And as a result, the state machinery of Pakistan becomes a victim of the polarized politics tenure after tenure.

6. Resolving the Issues and Challenges of Democracy in Pakistan And Making Pakistan a Polarized-Politics-Free State

6.1- The Election Commission of Pakistan must have a developed charter for the electoral procedures in Pakistan. The election commission of Pakistan must consider those parties eligible for election, after a tenure of less or more time, which are not conservative and not family centered. This trend must be abolished on urgently basis. And only those parties must be considered eligible for electoral process which must have a liberal ideology and not conservative and family centered. This will create a just trend of the election procedure and process and will lead to proper democratic governance.

6.2- Media must not be used by the politicians for personal name, fame, and gain. Media must be just and profound in this regard. Media must help make the institutions in Pakistan strong. Media must develop and support public awareness campaigns about good governance of a sophisticated democracy among Pakistani public. Media must surely take ensuring daily justice for the Pakistani public as one of its points in its agenda of transmission.

6.3- The economy of Pakistan must support the citizens of Pakistan, whether they are government servants or common public. Pakistani economy must be free from loans as much as possible. And there must be no bankruptcy at all and at any cost. This will

lower the trend of imposing taxes over masses. And the public will observe better economy of good governance in Pakistan.

6.4- The State Machinery of Pakistan must run on exact and productive rules. Where the institutions of this state will serve the public in a much better way, and the concerned responsible authorities will fulfil their duties and responsibilities more honestly. And the masses will enjoy as much accurate justice as it is possible in good democratic governance in this state of Pakistan.

6.5- Creating a new trend of good governance is dependent on each and every citizen of Pakistan. The trend of a good democracy and not a polarized governance in Pakistan will cast an impressive image of this state on the international forum also. Where both the domestic and foreign affairs of Pakistan will definitely cause the state machinery run on wanted grounds.

7. Conclusion.

Polarized politics and the issue and challenges because of it in democracy destroy the state affairs spoiling the ideology of democracy. Polarized politics is not a solution for the day by day pending and escalating issues and challenges in this country. Pakistan needs a shift in governance from polarized politics into a genuine democratic governance. Which is possible after the adoption and application of the above discussed measures, to make prosperity the destination for this state of Pakistan and its masses

4. Strategies needed For the Modifications in The Foreign Policy of Pakistan - While Surviving Amid the Global Power Dynamics

4.1- Pakistan needs to strengthen its ties more with both the Muslim and non-Muslim states for mutual packages on the economic fronts based on the skilled citizens of mutual countries. This will boost Pakistani economy, which will in-turn make Pakistan more solid.

4.5-Serving the USA must be done profoundly by Pakistan. Also, the USA must not use Pakistan for its strategic purposes only. USA must add economic colour to its foreign policy for this region also. This will

restrict the hard US involvement in this region. As the acquirement of peace with hard power is not that much easy as it is possible with soft power.

5- Potential Future Prospects Attached with Pakistan After Its Modified Foreign Policy - Among the Global Power Dynamics

5.1- Regional peace due to Pakistan because of being an active member of the regional organizations for peace and prosperity will encourage such organizations to have more and more seminars. This will strengthen Muslim brethren among Muslim states and will cast a shadow of restriction on the hard power involvement of the USA in this region.

5.2- Chinese support for Pakistan due to economic agreements will secure the economy of Pakistan as much as possible. Which will enrich the foreign policy of Pakistan with more prosperity towards other states. Which qualifies Pakistan for a better future.

5.3- US diplomacy towards Pakistan and this region on dual fronts, i.e. hard power and soft power will ensure more peace and prosperity for Asia. The whole Asia due to the geo-strategic position of Pakistan will get enriched with peace and prosperity because of the safe ties between the USA and Pakistan on the basis of foreign policy of Pakistan.

5.4- Safe Iranian up-gradation in the atomic procedures to become an atomic power will make Iran dedicate better security to this region, with restricted USA in this regard. Where in the foreign policy of Pakistan along with the help of other Muslim states concerned need to bring USA and Iran agreed on this point.

5.5.- Casting better relations towards India is crucial also. Resolving hard feelings from both the states of India and Pakistan against each other is a needed goal for the foreign policy of Pakistan. Which will make both the states integral for themselves. Also, the resolved Kashmir issue will help the UN get the two countries on one table for mutual productive relations without the loss of humans, time and resources any more. And will give a lesson of peace and prosperity on humanitarian basis to the outside world.

6. Making Pakistan a Challenging State with Its Geo-Strategic Position - Among the Global Power Dynamics - And Winning Over with The Foreign Policy of Pakistan

6.1- Pakistan has most desired geo-strategic location in this region for both the USA and the people's republic of china. Both the USA and china are a lot dependent on the state of Pakistan. USA depends on Pakistan for its diplomatic strategies, while China depends on the unique location of Pakistan for its economic strategies. Where Pakistan has integral personal strategies as far as its foreign policy is concerned and wins over both of the states of the USA and China.

6.4- Pakistan is like the significant regional hero country for other countries surrounding Pakistan, while the USA trying to reach and involve Pakistan in its strategies. This has caused the reputation of Pakistan get escalated and a lot works for Pakistan in this regard, because of the lucky geo-strategic location of Pakistan. 6. PAKISTAN'S INFORMAL ECONOMY: THE WAY FORWARD.

1. Introduction

Economy is the backbone of any state machinery. Almost all the affairs and concerns of a state mainly depend on its economy. The prosperity of any state gets back up from its economy. Pakistan's informal economy like any other state (either developed/under developed) has to cater the state in edibility, construction, and sustainability. Which enjoins upon each and every responsible citizen of Pakistan to play the input and out-put of his/her share in this economy.

2. Current Position of Pakistan's Informal Economy in A Spectrum of Focus - And the Dependence Criteria in This Regard

2.1- The less cared economy of Pakistan has a lack of that much support for the cause of Pakistani public. Pakistani society has various types of people as per their personal

economy, i.e. per capita income. All of them play their input and output share in the overall informal economy of Pakistan. The improvement of this input and output share of the citizens in economy depends on their life conditions as factors. Which includes poverty, illiteracy, and unemployment etc, of the citizens to add their role to the informal economy of Pakistan.

2.2- Pakistani economy is not pure from loans acquired from IMF and WB by the government(s). Where the politicians hardly manage the sustainability of the informal economy of Pakistan. As a result, the governments impose more and more taxes with time on the Pakistani citizens, who hardly manage these taxes to pay. Additional loans have caused bankruptcy in the Pakistan economy. Such carelessness of the government about the informal economy of Pakistan is triggering the sense of corruption in the authorities in power also. Where as in this society of Pakistan the most affected faction are the poor ones. Who survive with a trend of difficulty in their lives? Also, the IMF and World bank is in due to get paid to recover their loans in instalments from Pakistan.

2.3- Demand and supply in the informal economy of Pakistan must have a rich and healthy ratio, Poor citizens of Pakistan cannot afford the daily escalating prices of the goods daily used. These goods are domestic produces or imported from outside. Which needs to have affordable and convenient prices.

2.4- The commercial sector of Pakistan is not that much productive because of the lack of needed industries. However, alternately Pakistan is importing Chinese products and is dependent (like other countries) on the industrial and commercial sector of China. And that is the reason where because of the Chinese products the economy of Pakistan has become informal. Where the export of Pakistan needs to be genuinely improved to improve its informal economy.

2.5- Pakistani Currency is losing its cost constantly as compared to American Dollar in the international monetary market as the time passes., Stalk exchange of Pakistan is also getting badly affected because of the informality in the economy of Pakistan.

3. Currently Worsening and Possible Upcoming Challenges to Pakistan's Informal Economy

3.1- Public is overwhelming more and more with life challenges as the time passes. Also, the future of these masses looks dull with the passage of time. They use to become weaker to deal the challenges of life like poverty, unemployment, less income, and weak life standards worsening with time. On the other hand, the informal economy of Pakistan is also becoming weaker due the Pakistani currency losing its value and supporting less this public. The government giving minimum subsidy to the poor public.

3.2- Fatigued state machinery is exhausted anymore and needs refreshment by the polarized politicians. Weak institutions and corrupt dignitaries are a proof of exhausted state machinery. Acquiring loans is another blow from the IMF and WB by the less responsible politicians. Bankruptcy is escalating and is dragging back the informal economy of Pakistan with the passage of times because of acquiring loans from outside. Where the imposed taxes against the masses are unbearable for the public to pay.

3.3- There is an imbalance between the demand and supply of goods shattering the informal economy of Pakistan at times. More than exporting goods the trend of importing goods in the market has jeopardized the industrial and commercial sector of Pakistan. In this regard the Chinese products have seen a flourished future. Where the "CPEC" and "One Belt One Road (OBOR)" are mutual gifts of China and Pakistan for each other for the present and future, although. In order to get economy flourished more agreements with china are a pre-requisite.

3.4- The industrial sector of Pakistan is shrinking with the dependence on Chinese goods, Although the sale and purchase of goods is supporting the commercial sector of Pakistan, However, its enrichment needs to be depended on the domestic industries more than the imported ones, with the resolved power supply issue. In this regard more domestic industries require plantation in Pakistan.

3.5- The loss of the value of the Pakistani currency from time to time both in the domestic and international market is a headache for Pakistan. The challenge of improving stalk exchange is also a proof of the lack of economic prosperity.

4. Measures to Adopt-Apply for The Improvement of Pakistan's Informal Economy - To Eradicate and Avoid Challenges

4.1- The domestic produce must be brought in focus and existence to give primary route to the economic policy of Pakistan. No loans from IMF and WB will be given room in the economic policy of Pakistan anymore. The least possible taxes should be imposed on the public of Pakistan. As these are not the citizens who are the only responsible individuals to save the economy of Pakistan with the payment of taxes and give a forward way to the informal economy of Pakistan. The corrupt authorities in power are also responsible in this regard, to whom the constitution of Pakistan assign the task of securing the economy. There must be no room of bankruptcy in the economy also. Which is a sign of jeopardized economy primarily.

4.2- Institutions must be strong enough like they are in other countries. There must be strict accountability and harsh consequences for the corrupt authorities to have a lesson for others. Government must work for the public to ensure daily justice on urgently basis, with a purified economy. Which will be a proof of a certified economy of Pakistan.

4.3- There is a need of more Import and export agreements with other countries, as much as the economy of Pakistan can afford and will get flourished with. Also, more than importing goods the ratio of exporting goods must be much more. Which will enrich this economy and will create more jobs and will spread commercial prosperity across Pakistan.

4.4- There is an urgent need of caring about the state machinery of Pakistan. In this regard man power must be reared. While these rearing needs securing the prosperity of the citizens. Where the govt is in due to keep resolving the daily life challenges of the public in the form of providing them conducive income.

5.5- Exposing the Islamic cultural values and lack of proper interest in the unity of Muslim ummah by Pakistan has added an ill-fated scar to the bad reputation of Pakistan in this regard, making it a weak Muslim state in this regard.

6. Making Pakistan Ready for The Digital Revolution

6.1- Islam is the most purely describing religion of nature in the world. In the digital revolution scientists are all striving hard to investigate the nature and disclose its secrets and realities. Where Islam been the religion and culture of Pakistan has such realities been defined in the Holy Quran, Holey Ahadith, and Holy Islamic Scriptures

already. Where the scientists need to have the study of Islam and Culture of Pakistan. Hence from the religious and cultural point of view Pakistan with some efforts to cure the debilities is ready for the digital revolution.
